



Attributes of the Almighty

“His Almighty Faithfulness” Duet. 7:7-11

Malachi. 3:6, “For I am the LORD, I change not; therefore ye sons of Jacob are not consumed.”

I. HE IS FAITHFUL IN HIS PERSONALITY (DEUTERONOMY 7:9A)

Isaiah. 46:9, “Remember the former things of old: for I am God, and there is none else; I am God, and there is none like me,”

A. TRUTHFUL – HE KEEPS HIS WORD

Psalm 119:160, “Thy word is true from the beginning: and every one of thy righteous judgments endureth for ever.”

John 14:6, “Jesus saith unto him, I am the way, the truth, and the life: no man cometh unto the Father, but by me.”

Romans 3:4, “God forbid: yea, let God be true, but every man a liar; as it is written, That thou mightest be justified in thy sayings, and mightest overcome when thou art judged.”

Deuteronomy 32:4, “He is the Rock, his work is perfect: for all his ways are judgment: a God of truth and without iniquity, just and right is he.”

B. IMMUTABLE – HE DOES NOT CHANGE

James 1:17, “Every good gift and every perfect gift is from above, and cometh down from the Father of lights, with whom is no variableness, neither shadow of turning.”

The word **variableness** is from the Greek work **parallage** (παράλλαγη , par-al-lag-ay) which means transmutation, fickleness or changing.

II. HE IS FAITHFUL IN HIS PROVISION (DEUTERONOMY 7:8)

A. PROVISION OF PHYSICAL NEEDS

Genesis 8:22, “While the earth remaineth, seedtime and harvest, and cold and heat, and summer and winter, and day and night shall not cease.”

This planet annually produces enough food for all our physical needs. God has provided for every generation.

Psalm 37:25, “I have been young, and now am old; yet have I not seen the righteous forsaken, nor his seed begging bread.”

B. PROVISION OF EMOTIONAL NEEDS (DEUTERONOMY 7:8A)

Love is more than an emotion; it is an action of my will under the direction of God.

Jeremiah 31:3, “The LORD hath appeared of old unto me, saying, Yea, I have loved thee with an everlasting love: therefore with lovingkindness have I drawn thee.”

Lamentations 3:22, “It is of the LORD’S mercies that we are not consumed, because his compassions fail not.”

If you look to men to encourage you, you will often be discouraged. But if you will look to the Cross you will see that His compassion fails not, His love endures, and His Spirit comforts.

C. PROVISION OF SPIRITUAL NEEDS

Our spiritual sustenance comes from the Word of God. God’s Word will fill you up.

Psalm 119:89, “For ever, O LORD, thy word is settled in heaven.”

Psalm 119:138, “Thy testimonies that thou hast commanded are righteous and very faithful.”

III. HE IS FAITHFUL IN HIS PROMISES (DEUTERONOMY 7:9-11)

A. HIS PROMISE TO SAVE

God has promised that anyone who comes to the realization that he is a sinner, who has no hope apart from Jesus Christ, can come to Christ believing He is God and that He has paid for all our sin on the cross of Calvary and has risen again to bring us the victory over sin, over death and over Hell, will be saved.

Hebrews 7:24-25, “²⁴ But this man, because he continueth ever, hath an unchangeable priesthood. ²⁵ Wherefore he is able also to save them to the uttermost that come unto God by him, seeing he ever liveth to make intercession for them.”

B. HIS PROMISE TO FORGIVE

I John 1:9, “If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just to forgive us our sins, and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.”

C. HIS PROMISE TO KEEP

II Timothy 1:12, “For the which cause I also suffer these things: nevertheless I am not ashamed: for I know whom I have believed, and am persuaded that he is able to keep that which I have committed unto him against that day.”
