



Psalm 105:5, "Remember his marvellous works that he hath done; his wonders, and the judgments of his mouth;"

Psalm 77:11-12, "I will remember the works of the LORD: surely I will remember thy wonders of old. I will meditate also of all thy work, and talk of thy doings."

## I. HE IS FAITHFUL TO FORGET

Hebrews 8:12, "For I will be merciful to their unrighteousness, and their sins and their iniquities will I remember no more."

### A. BY HIS MERCY WE ARE SUSTAINED (LAMENTATIONS 3:22)

Malachi 3:6, "For I am the LORD, I change not; therefore ye sons of Jacob are not consumed."

Psalm 86:15, "But thou, O Lord, art a God full of compassion, and gracious, longsuffering, and plenteous in mercy and truth."

Psalms 30:5, "For his anger endureth but a moment; in his favour is life: weeping may endure for a night, but joy cometh in the morning."

### B. BY HIS MERCY WE ARE SUPPLIED (LAMENTATIONS 3:23)

1. He will supply completely.

Philippians 4:19, "But my God shall supply all your need according to his riches in glory by Christ Jesus."

2. He will supply continuously.

Psalms 37:25-26, "I have been young, and now am old; yet have I not seen the righteous forsaken, nor his seed begging bread. He is ever merciful, and lendeth; and his seed is blessed."

3. He will supply strength.

Hebrews 4:16, "Let us therefore come boldly unto the throne of grace, that we may obtain mercy, and find grace to help in time of need."

## II. HE IS FAITHFUL TO FEED

I Peter 2:1-2, "Wherefore laying aside all malice, and all guile, and hypocrisies, and envies, and all evil speakings, As newborn babes, desire the sincere milk of the word, that ye may grow thereby:"

### A. HIS WORD NOURISHES US

Jeremiah 15:16, "Thy words were found, and I did eat them; and thy word was unto me the joy and rejoicing of mine heart: for I am called by thy name, O LORD God of hosts."

### B. HIS WORD FURNISHES US

II Timothy 3:16-17, "All scripture is given by inspiration of God, and is profitable for doctrine, for reproof, for correction, for instruction in righteousness: That the man of God may be perfect, thoroughly furnished unto all good works."

### C. HIS WORD ENCOURAGES US

I Thessalonians 2:13, "For this cause also thank we God without ceasing, because, when ye received the word of God which ye heard of us, ye received it not as the word of men, but as it is in truth, the word of God, which effectually worketh also in you that believe."

## III. HE IS FAITHFUL TO FORGIVE

Psalms 103:12, "As far as the east is from the west, so far hath he removed our transgressions from us."

Psalms 32:1-2, "Blessed is he whose transgression is forgiven, whose sin is covered. Blessed is the man unto whom the LORD imputeth not iniquity, and in whose spirit there is no guile."

### A. WE ARE FORGIVEN THROUGH HIS BLOOD

Ephesians 1:7, "In whom we have redemption through his blood, the forgiveness of sins, according to the riches of his grace;"

### B. WE ARE FORGIVEN FOR HIS SAKE

I John 2:12, "I write unto you, little children, because your sins are forgiven you for his name's sake."

Colossians 3:13, "Forbearing one another, and forgiving one another, if any man have a quarrel against any: even as Christ forgave you, so also do ye."

### C. WE ARE FORGIVEN FOR OUR UNRIGHTEOUSNESS

Romans 5:8-9, "But God commendeth his love toward us, in that, while we were yet sinners, Christ died for us. Much more then, being now justified by his blood, we shall be saved from wrath through him."

I John 1:9-10, "If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just to forgive us our sins, and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness. If we say that we have not sinned, we make him a liar, and his word is not in us."

Titus 3:7, "That being justified by his grace, we should be made heirs according to the hope of eternal life."

Romans 4:7-8, "Saying, Blessed are they whose iniquities are forgiven, and whose sins are covered. Blessed is the man to whom the Lord will not impute sin."
